

**BSol CCG: Covid 19 – Consumables Emergency Expenses for General Practice Providers Process 24.3.2020**

1. To respond to general practice business requests, and reduce time for pre-approval of certain items of additional expenditure above normal practice stock re Covid19, the items listed below can be purchased with prior authorisation.
2. An on account payment will be made to each practice in w/c 30 March 2020. Practices are required to keep a record of costs associated with the on account payment for subsequent submission of a claim to the CCG. Proof of purchases should be held within the practice for audit purposes and subsequent validation.
3. The value limits for total purchases on these items are calculated as follows: up to a value of £1000 per practice up to a practice list of 5,000, plus a further £50 per additional 1000 list above 5000. E.g. a practice of 40,000 list would have a maximum of £2,750 available: £1,000 for 5000 list plus £1,750 for 35,000/1000 list @ £50.

**Pre-approved items: - in excess of normal practice stock**

- Thermometers
- BP monitors
- Pulse oximeters
- cleaning equipment and products
- Hand sanitisers/disinfectants
- Stationery
