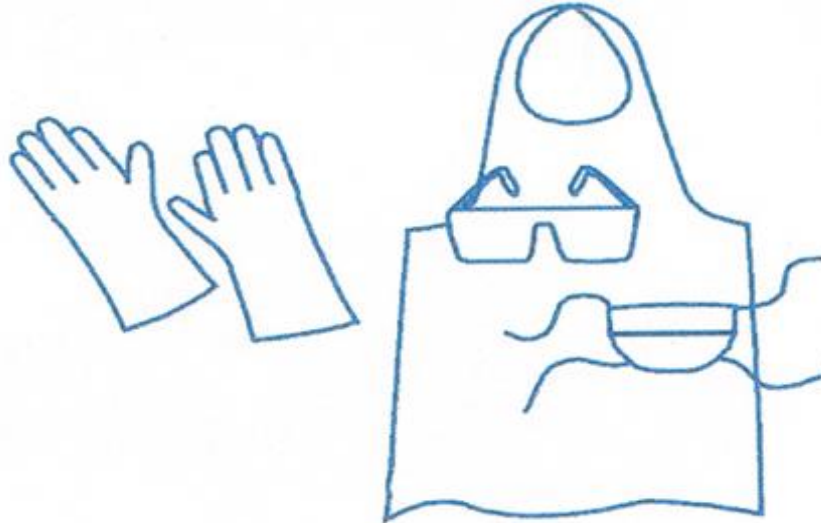


REMINDER:

COVID-19 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



Sustained Community Transmission in UK
COVID-19 is common in the community =
Your PPE is still needed!!!!

This includes:

- **Wearing PPE for all residents** e.g. those who are confirmed with COVID-19, those who are suspected with symptoms and for those that have no symptoms at all
- **PPE is needed for all personal care**, for example: assisting with getting in/out of bed, feeding, dressing, bathing, grooming, toileting, applying dressings etc. and or when unintended contact with residents is likely (e.g. when caring for residents with challenging behaviour)
- **PPE** should be worn in line with national guidance (see below link section 1, recommendation tables 1 and 2) for ALL Care Home staff e.g. carers, domestic staff, administrators etc.
